Participants who become skilled in various Data Care professions should expect to be hired in jobs that pay at least \$70,000. After 2 years on the job, Data Care professionals can expect to earn over \$110,000. There is no ceiling to the amount that Data Care professionals can earn. Jobs are available in health sciences, banking, retail sales, financial services, legal services, engineering, government, military, construction, entertainment, and more.
